Effective immediately, repair systems for the transmission (E-Axle RepSystem-G) and for the electric motor (E-Axle RepSystem-M) are available for these vehicle models: Hyundai Ioniq AE-EV, Volkswagen eGolf VII with 100 kW and 85 kW, Volkswagen eUp, BMW I3, and Nissan Leaf.
