Specifically, Schaeffler is focusing on establishing regional remanufacturing centers to refurbish bearings locally on a larger scale – with Alstom as a pilot customer. The first workshops have already been equipped and trained accordingly.

“Such regional remanufacturing hubs are intended to be established worldwide in the future and will also be open to other Schaeffler partners,” says Dr. Michael Holzapfel, Global Sector Lead Rail at Schaeffler. “In this way, we are not only promoting the sustainable use of resources. With our 100 percent return service, we ensure that the refurbished bearings meet the same quality and safety standards as new products, including warranty coverage.”
