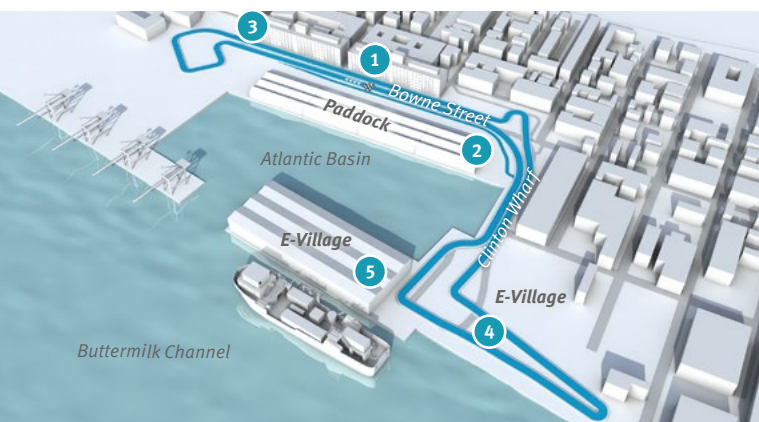

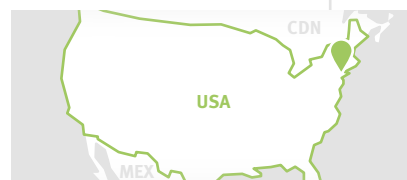

The city and Formula E

For the third time in succession, the fully electric racing series is traveling to New York City. The U.S. metropolis is hosting the season's finale for the second time after 2018. As before, two races will be held on the city circuit on Brooklyn's waterfront on one weekend.

Local mobility

New York City has ambitious environmental goals: an 80-percent reduction of greenhouse gas emissions by 2050; at least 20 – versus currently 0.4 – percent of all newly registered cars to use electric power. Notably, in 1901, 50 percent of the cars in "NYC" were electric.

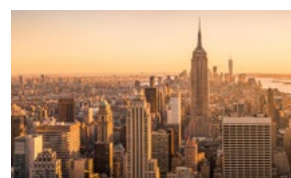
