Coupa – working on one global platform

As a supplier you will find all the relevant information and access all necessary documents within one place. This will enable you to bid and interact with Schaeffler more effectively.

^{*} Non Production Material = Indirect materials or indirect requirements include all goods and services that are required for the ongoing operation of a company but are not a direct component of the end products.

Definition of auction types

English reverse auction

Similar to the classic reverse auction except that there is an obligation for a supplier to take the lead – each bid must be lower than the current lowest bid. The auction ends when the leading bid remains unbeaten for a specified of time. Both this and the classic auction tend to work well where there are a larger number of suppliers bidding – the suppliers can see other bids and this creates a more competitive environment than providing quotes and negotiating in isolation.

Dutch reverse auction

The buyer sets a low starting bid and at pre-determined intervals the price increases until one supplier accepts that price. There is less transparency in this type of auction as a supplier cannot see the number of competitors or any activity until the first bid is placed and the auction ends.

This type of event can work well where there are less suppliers (as there is no knowledge or visibility of what others are doing and therefore no pressure on moving with the pack) and also where a quick event is required (as it ends after the first bid).

Japanese reverse auction

A Japanese auction is a version of a clock auction. In the buying setting, the price starts high and is decreased by a preset amount over time. Each participant has to accept the call-out price in each step, otherwise they are out. The last participant to bid wins the item.

Now you will be able to enter your bids. If you have participated in the RfQ before, you will see your entered bids as starting price.


Please enter your price and click "Submit Bids".





- By clicking the Accept bid button at the bottom right in the Items and Lots section, you accept the total cost and the auction is ended.









Participating in a Japanese Reverse Auction



As soon as the bidding phase starts, the clock starts ticking and the start prices are changed as established in the item specifications.

You will see the list of items, the expected quantity, the changing call-out price, and the resulting total cost for each item as well as the total cost of all items at the current interval.

You also see a clock indicating time to next change of the price, the time between price changes is stated in the Event Information & Bidding Rules section in the Event info page.

Each participant has to accept the total cost at each step. By clicking the **Agree to Price** button, you accept the total cost and remains active in the auction. Not accepting, closes the auction for you.
